Before reading the map, hold the map with your desired direction of travel pointing directly in front of you.

Then rotate yourself and the map so that the north arrows on the map point towards magnetic north.

Don't forget to check the legend.

1. 31 Quarry, NW edge, top
 2. 32 Manmade object, E side
 3. 33 NE Boulder, 1.8 m, NE side
 4. 34 Boulder, 0.8 m, W side
 5. 35 Termite mound, 1.5 m, E side
 6. 36 Manmade object, N side
 7. 37 Head of NW gully
 8. 38 Boulder, 1.6 m, N side
 9. 39 Native cherry tree, 6 m, E side
 10. 40 Log seat, northeast end
- Finish Bridge



This is what the markers look like (about 40 cm high). They are located at the circle centres.
Note: most are faded and some may be missing so it is recommended to use the MapRun phone app.
